HOW TO REACH THE CREMOPAR FROM THE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT OF NAPLES?

- Once landed and left the airport of Naples go by walk towards the Naples Capodichino airport terminal bus, in the avenue F. Rufo di Calabria, and take the bus ALIBUS to the Naples central train station in Piazza Garibaldi.

You can buy ticket in board for 5€. The bus leaves every 15 minutes.

- From Naples train station take a regional train to Battipaglia FS train station, located in Salerno province. The duration of the trip is about an hour and a half. It's possible to buy the ticket directly in the Naples central train station.
- From Battipaglia train station there will be a transfer waiting (organized by the congress) for you to reach the CREMOPAR by car.
